**LATER:**

The Court having taken this matter under advisement,

**IT IS ORDERED** granting the Petition to Compel Appraisal without prejudice for the Court to determine coverage issues by declaratory action following the appraisal process. The intent of this Order is to fix the amount in controversy prior to litigating any declaratory action.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that following the appraisal process, if Defendant chooses to proceed with the declaratory action, that Defendant shall file a more definite statement of the declaratory action than that filed as part of the Motion to Dismiss filed on January 11, 2012.
