5. All discovery shall be completed on or before **February 6, 2006**. No discovery done after that date, whether on stipulation or not, shall be used at trial unless the Court enters a written order permitting such discovery.
6. Setting this matter for a telephonic Status Conference on **Monday, June 6, 2005 at 9:00 a.m.** to review the status/progress of discovery. Plaintiff's counsel shall arrange and initiate the conference call to this Court at 602-506-3727.
7. The parties shall participate in a settlement conference through outside resources. The Court is not ordering any specific date at this time for the completion of said conference.

If counsel encounter any difficulty complying with the above deadlines, counsel should advise the Court as soon as possible so that the discovery issues can be resolved in sufficient advance of the proposed trial in this matter.
