10:05 a.m. IN CHAMBERS: This is the time set for Status Conference. Plaintiff is represented by counsel, James Braselton. Defendants are represented by counsel, Steven Hirsch.

Carrie Newman, Court Reporter, is present.

This case having been reassigned to this division, discussion is held regarding pretrial matters.

Defendant's counsel advises that his appraiser Peter Martori has not finished his appraisal and has not been deposed and requests to continue the trial.

IT IS ORDERED denying Defendant's Motion to Continue the Trial and further that Peter Martori file his appraisal **by October 15, 2003**.

IT IS ORDERED affirming the trial date of **December 15, 2003, four (4) days to a jury**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED affirming all of the dates and requirements set forth in Judge Hilliard's August 4, 2003 Minute Entry.

Judge Hilliard had ruled on Plaintiff's Motion in Limine and withdrew the ruling because of the recusal.

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This court has reviewed the Plaintiff's Motion in Limine Re Exclusion of Defendants' Potential Expert Witness (Peter J. Martori) and Unidentified Potential "Real Estate Broker" Witness.

IT IS ORDERED denying Plaintiff's Motion in Limine; however, if Mr. Martori's appraisal report is not filed by October 15, 2003, Plaintiff's counsel may reurge his previously filed motion in limine.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. Martori's testimony at trial will be strictly limited to those opinions expressed in his appraisal report.
